WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

Type:

This investment fund is a Qualifying Investor Alternative Investment Fund (QIAIF).

This product is not subject to any fixed term.

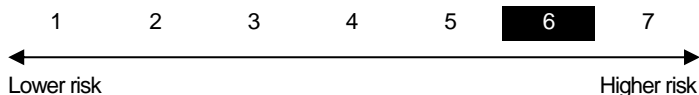
Objectives:

The Sub-Fund is an actively managed portfolio of global equities. Comprising Transferable Securities, including bonds and equities listed on recognised markets, exchange traded funds ("ETFs"), collective investment schemes and exposures to commodities. The Fund may use FFCT's, futures, options for EPM.

Intended Retail Investor:

This Fund may not be suitable for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less. You may not be able to cash in early.

Risk indicator

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as class 6 out of 7, which the second highest risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a high level, and poor market conditions are very likely to impact the capacity of the fund to pay you.

The underlying funds may include illiquid assets such as alternative funds, real estate funds and/or non-quoted assets. These assets incur additional risks which are not considered in the indicator shown above when they do not represent a significant part of the underlying funds. These risks are that these assets could not be sold or not sold at the desired time and / or lead to significant losses. WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods:

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

- EUR 10 000 is invested.
