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COOKIE SETTINGS

Overview

A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website – when visited by a user – asks the browser to store on the device to remember information about the visit. Cookies set by the website are called first-party cookies. This website also uses third-party cookies – which are cookies from a domain different than the domain of the website you are visiting – for performance, marketing, and other efforts. More specifically, cookies and other tracking technologies are used for the following purposes:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the site will not then work if manually disabled. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

Performance Cookies

These cookies provide overall visit counts and traffic sources in order to measure and improve the performance of the website. They help provide information on which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If performance cookies are disabled, your usage of the site will not contribute to our website performance metrics.

Third-Party Cookies

These cookies may be set through our site by our technical partners. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites. They do not store directly personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.
